

Resolution Authorizing Participation in the HGAC Co-Operative Purchasing Program Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:10-12a

WHEREAS, the Borough of Wharton, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:10-12a and N.J.A.C. 5:1, may by resolution and without advertising for bids, purchase any goods or services under the Houston-Galveston Area Council Co-Operative Purchasing Program for any county contracts entered into on behalf of the participating agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Wharton has the need on a timely basis to purchase goods or services utilizing Houston-Galveston Area Council Co-Operative contracts; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Wharton intends to enter into contracts with Houston-Galveston Area Council Co-Operative Vendors through this resolution and properly executed contracts, which shall be subject to all the conditions applicable to the current Houston-Galveston Area Council Co-Operative contracts;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough of Wharton authorizes the Borough Administrator to purchase certain goods or services from those approved Houston-Galveston Area Council Co-Operative Contract Vendors, pursuant to all conditions of the individual Bergen County Co-Operative contracts; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the governing body of the Borough of Wharton pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:1, the certification of available funds, shall either certify the full maximum amount against the budget at the time the contract is awarded, or no contract amount shall be chargeable or certified until such time as the goods or services are ordered or otherwise called for prior to placing the order, and a certification of availability of funds is made by the Chief Finance Officer; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of the contracts between the Borough of Wharton and the Houston-Galveston Area Council Co-Operative Contract Vendors shall be from December 7, 2020 to December 31, 2021.
