Cats & Dogs need to be licensed every year in January.

2026 Clean Communities day is June 6th. We are looking for volunteers.

Second Thursday of every month the Town Hall is open late until 7:30pm & closes the following Friday at 12:30pm, other than certain Election weeks.

Drop Box for payments when Town Hall is closed is located inside the front vestibule on W. Central Ave. entrance.

No parking on streets when they are snow covered. Sidewalks must be shoveled 24 hours after the snowfall stops.

Homeowners are responsible for removing any grass growing in the curb & sidewalk areas.

Law prohibits computers, monitors, laptops & televisions to be put out for trash collection without a sticker.

Electronic waste stickers may be purchased at Town Hall.

Important Facts Concerning Garbage, Recycling and Yard Waste Pick-Up

(NOTE – COLLECTIONS START AT 6:00 AM)

The Borough is divided into two (2) collection zones: Zones A and B. A complete list of the zones and corresponding streets is found in this calendar. Once you have located the zone that your street is in, please refer to the calendar for your scheduled pick-up day. During Holiday weeks, check the calendar for any changes in the pick-up schedule. Please note that it is mandatory that your garbage be in town issued garbage carts. **Plastic bags left at the curbside will not be picked up.** Also note that waste containers may be put out to the curb no earlier than 6 PM the preceding evening, in accordance with local ordinance and must be brought in by 8 PM on date of collection.

Borough Recycling Depot is located at the corner of North Main St. & Pine St.

Recycling Center Hours: Mon.: 8am-2pm, Tues.: 8am-2pm, Wed.: 1pm-6pm, Thurs.: 8am-2pm, Fri.: 1pm-6pm, Sat. & Sun.: 8am-1pm.

Collection Stickers: Bulk items left at the curb will be picked up *only* with the appropriate collection sticker on them. Stickers are \$10.00 each. Tires will be picked up providing the rims are removed and there are tire stickers on them. The cost is \$3.00 for the 1st tire and \$2.00 for every tire thereafter. All stickers are available at Borough Hall. The fee will be waived for senior citizens (62 years or older), qualifying volunteers and the disabled, with proper identification.

Paint Cans: Only empty or dried up **LATEX** paint cans with the lids off will be accepted.

Construction Material: The disposal of any construction material resulting from new construction or renovations to homes is the responsibility of the owner.

Freon: It is a state law that no one be allowed to dispose of any appliance that has Freon in it. You must have a certified technician remove the Freon properly, and obtain a statement from them to this affect. Please bring this statement to Borough Hall to purchase a collection sticker

Doors: It is the law that all doors be removed from items such as refrigerators, washers and dryers, etc., before putting them out to the curb.

Yard Waste and Bagged Leaves will be picked up on designated days between April 6th and November 23rd: Grass clippings and leaves may be mixed and put in either trash cans or brown leaf bags. Brown leaf bags are available at Recycling Depot from April through November. Please avoid allowing the bags to get wet, as they are biodegradable. Plastic bags are not permitted. Brush must be clean and separate from grass and leaves and put in either barrels or bundled in lengths not to exceed 4 feet.

Loose Leaf (curbside) Pickup: Residents can put their loose leaves out to the curb between October 19, 2026 and December 4, 2026 for curbside pickup (raked to the curb) **LEAVES MUST BE A MINIMUM OF 7 FT. FROM CATCH BASINS.** Please note that streets have not been assigned a specific day or week as the Leaf Vacs will be operating daily as required and permitted, barring any unforeseeable circumstances. If there is a forecast for snow, please do not put leaves out at the curb as they will be picked up with the snow by the plows.

PLEASE NOTE – During inclement weather, sanitation, recyclable and yard waste may not be picked up until your next regularly scheduled day. Please take in your trash if it is not picked up. We apologize, in advance, for any inconvenience this may cause, and thank you for your patience and understanding in this matter.




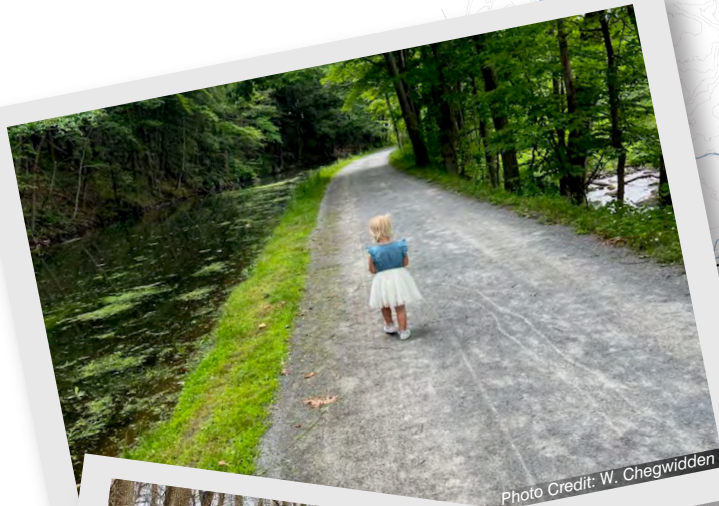


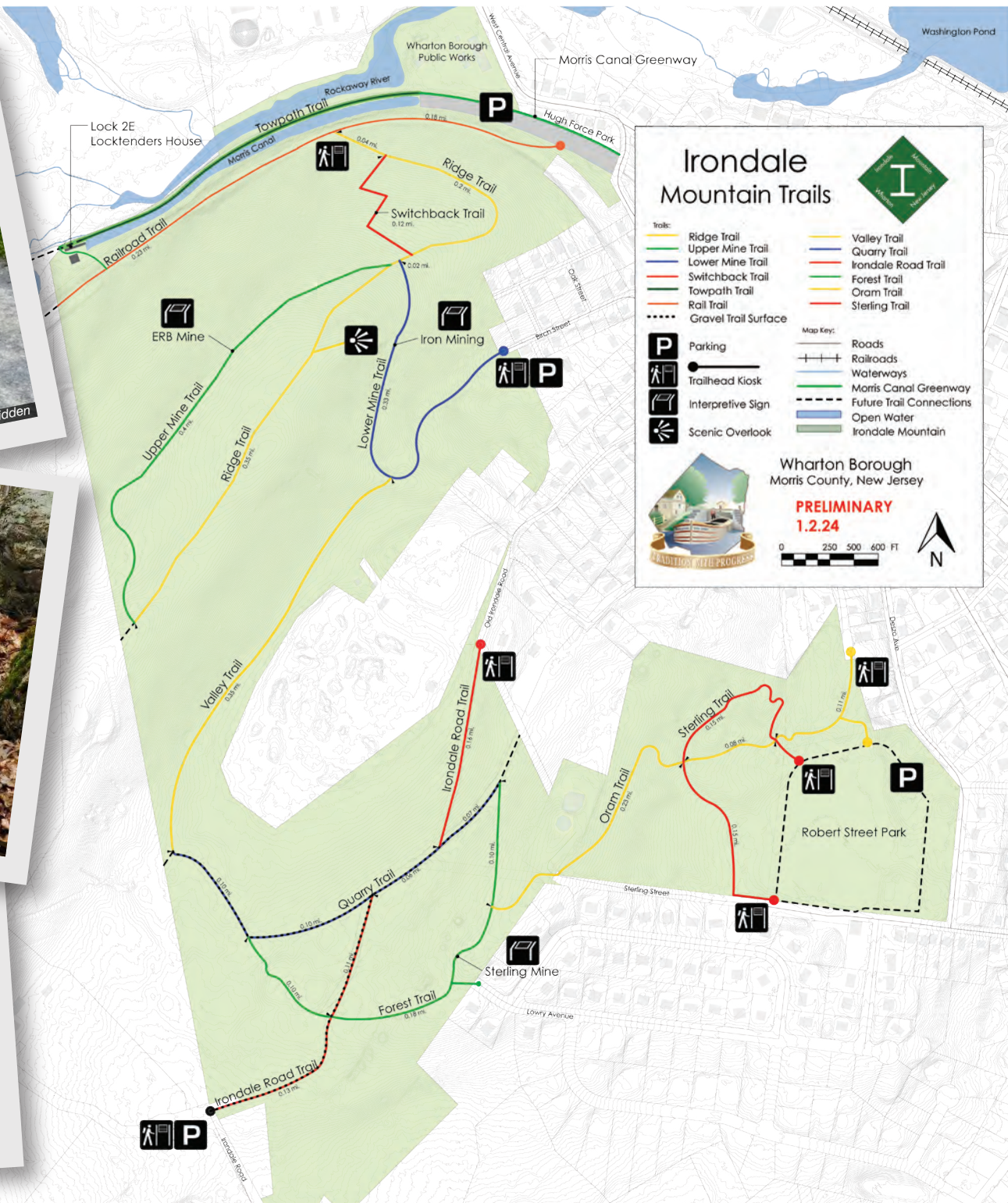

ZONING/HOUSING

Remember to contact the Zoning/Housing Official before you sell your home, erect a fence, remove or trim a tree or add or change a driveway. If you are in doubt as to whether you need a permit, contact the Zoning/Housing Department at 973-361-8444 ext. 2721 or the Construction Department at 973-361-8444 ext. 2719. Landlords must also notify the Zoning/Housing Official every time they change tenants and must be registered with the State or the Borough of Wharton. All landlords are required to register yearly. The Housing Department includes an enforcement officer, who conducts night and/or weekend inspections, on a regular basis.

PROPERTY MAINTENANCE

The Borough has an Ordinance requiring residents to maintain their property in good condition. It also requires residents to keep curbs fronting their property free from garbage, debris and weeds or other vegetation. The complete Ordinance can be obtained at Borough Hall or online at whartonnj.com. Vacant properties must be registered with the Borough. Also, any complaints about violations of the Code should be directed to the Zoning/Housing Officer at 973-361-8444 Ext. 2721.

CONSTRUCTION

One of the most commonly asked questions of the construction department is, what documentation is needed in order for one to apply for a permit. The answer to this question depends on what you are constructing. Visit our website for more info about construction.

All open permits must be closed out before a home or building can be sold.

CALL BEFORE YOU DIG: The “One Call Law” requires that anyone digging must call **1-800-272-1000** so that underground utilities can be marked out. You must wait 3 business days for your mark out and not more than 10 days before you start your project. Projects can vary from installing a mailbox post to building a house.

DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

The Borough of Wharton provides many services to its residents at reduced rates, including blood work, flu shots, blood pressure screenings and follow up on any communicable diseases. To receive information on these programs please contact the Borough Nurse, at 973-361-8444 ext. 2715. The Health Department is also responsible for the inspection of all Retail Food Establishments and the enforcement of many State and Borough Codes. Your questions should be directed to the Borough Environmental Health Specialist who can be reached at 973-361-8444 Ext. 2715.

DOG/CAT LICENSING

Any person who owns, keeps or harbors a dog/cat over the age of six months must, within ten days after he obtains possession of such dog/cat, apply for a license "and **annually** thereafter" Renewal must be done in the month of January

FEES FOR DOG & CAT - \$14.00 – SPAYED/NEUTERED \$17.00 NOT SPAYED/NEUTERED

A delinquent fee of \$5.00 per month per animal shall be added to a dog/cat renewal license for licenses issued after January 31, 2026. When applying for a license, please bring proof of current rabies vaccination valid through November 1, 2026 and proof that the dog or cat is neutered or spayed.

IF YOU NO LONGER HAVE THE DOG/CAT, YOU MUST NOTIFY THE TOWN AT 973-361-8444 X 2710

It is a State Law that **all pets must be vaccinated against rabies.** Rabies is present in the State and all pets are required to be vaccinated. The Borough runs a free rabies clinic every year. There are other free clinics in Morris County throughout the year. We would like to remind you not to handle wild animals. If you and your pet do come in contact with a wild animal, contact your doctor or veterinarian immediately.

STAYING INFORMED DURING EMERGENCIES

During any emergency it is important to stay informed. It is because of this that the Borough of Wharton utilizes a variety of ways to keep our residents and businesses up to date.

During emergencies power may not be available and all energy dependent devices may not be a reliable source of information unless you are able to keep them charged.

The Borough Of Wharton utilizes the following methods of communication to our residents:

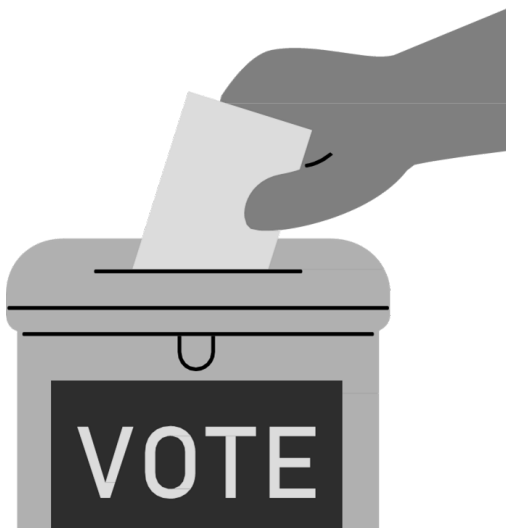


