**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 213, SECTION 4 G-4 OF THE REVISED
GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF WHARTON, COUNTY OF
MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Wharton that Chapter 213 Parks and Recreation Areas, Section 4 G-4 Rules and Regulations, Prohibited Acts, Domestic Animals of the revised general ordinances of the Borough of Wharton is hereby amended as follows:

Chapter 213. Parks and Recreation Areas

G. Prohibited acts.

(4) Domestic animals. Have been responsible for the entry of a dog or other domestic animal into areas other than automobile parking concourses and walks immediately adjacent thereto and in such other areas as may be clearly marked by signs bearing the words "Domestic Animals Permitted in this Area." Except within a confined area designated and clearly marked with signs by the Mayor and Council as a "dog park," all dogs in those areas where such animals are permitted shall be restrained at all times on adequate leashes not greater than eight feet in length. Dogs may go unleashed while in the "dog park," however all persons accompanying a dog or puppy must use a leash when taking the dog or puppy to and from the "dog park." Except as hereinabove specifically noted, nothing herein shall be construed as permitting the running of dogs at large.
