**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PERSON TO PERSON AND PLACE TO PLACE
TRANSFER OF A PLENARY RETAIL CONSUMPTION LICENSE**

WHEREAS, an application has been filed for a Person-to-Person and Place-to-Place Transfer of Plenary Retail Consumption License Number 1439-33-007-008, heretofore issued to Canal Corp. for premises located at inactive; and

WHEREAS, the submitted application form is complete in all respects, the transfer fees have been paid, and the license has been properly renewed for the current license term; and

WHEREAS, the applicant is qualified to be licensed according to all standards established by Title 33 of the New Jersey Statutes, regulations promulgated thereunder, as well as pertinent local ordinances and conditions consistent with Title 33; and

WHEREAS, the applicant has disclosed and the issuing authority reviewed the source of all funds used in the purchase of the license and the licensed business and all additional financing obtained in connection with the licensed business.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wharton does hereby approve, effective November 18, 2024, the transfer of the aforesaid Plenary Retail Consumption License to Colossal Bar LLC. and does hereby direct the Municipal Clerk to endorse the license certificate to the new ownership as follows: "This license, subject to all its terms and conditions, is hereby transferred to Colossal Bar LLC effective November 18, 2024."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wharton does hereby approve, effective November 18, 2024, the Place-to-Place Transfer of the aforesaid Plenary Retail Consumption licensed premises, from its former location at inactive, to its new location of 392 N. Main St. Wharton, NJ, and does hereby direct the Municipal Clerk to endorse the license certificate as follows: "This license, subject to all its terms and conditions, is hereby transferred to 392 N. Main St. Wharton, NJ effective November 18, 2024"
