

**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE
BOROUGH OF WHARTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE
POLICE CHIEF TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF WHARTON POLICE DEPARTMENT,
MORRIS COUNTY PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE, AND THE MENTAL HEALTH
ASSOCIATION OF MORRIS AND ESSEX COUNTY TO ESTABLISH JOINT
PARTICIPATION TO ENHANCE AND SUPPORT RESPONSE TO CERTAIN
BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CRISIS CALLS**

WHEREAS, a memorandum of understanding has been promulgated by the Morris County Prosecutor and the Borough of Wharton to provide mental health services through the Police Department and the "Arrive Together Program" to support and enhance law enforcement and response to certain behavioral health crisis calls; and

WHEREAS, the memorandum of understanding has been approved by the Morris County Prosecutor's Office and Municipal Attorney; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the Memorandum of Understanding is available for public inspection in the office of the Municipal Clerk.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Wharton in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey that the Police Chief is authorized to execute the Memorandum of Understanding between the Borough of Wharton, the Morris County Prosecutor's Office, and the Mental Health Association of Essex and Morris County.
